

True Globalism

"In the world you shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world."

There is much talk in our modern culture about Globalism. Yet very few, indeed have even the slightest inkling about just what this word really means, for True Globalism is *'the triumph of an individual over the world in which they live.'* This is because True Globalism can only take place on an individual basis. It occurs when we possess a Global, or Universal state of consciousness, in which we become Spiritually Illumined, or Enlightened. Ironically, such a condition causes us to become *'Spiritually Homeless,'* where we are no longer bound by the dictates and dogmas of any particular nation, culture, religion or philosophical creed.

Instead, we must learn to live according to the Principles of Universal Truth that transcend any particular national identity. Philosophically, this is the true essence of Libertarianism, which advocates that everyone should be free to live their lives as they choose, according to the timeless Principles of Truth that have guided Humanity down through the ages.

The significance of this approach is contained within the teachings of the great German spiritual philosopher Rudolph Steiner who wrote, *"We can talk forever about Brotherly Love and the common good of Humanity, we can create thousands of fraternal organizations; but they will not lead to the desired goal of world peace, regardless of how well-intentioned we may be. The point is, we must embrace right understanding in order to know how to create a universal bond of brotherhood and sisterhood for all of Humanity. Only those whose lives are grounded in the principles of universal Truth, which are valid for all human beings, will be able to*

find themselves abiding together in that Truth, which is Love.

Just as the sun at the center of our solar system unites the many planets which are striving towards it, those planets yet remain individually separate. In like manner, when all individual human beings are striving towards a common Truth, they will come together as a cohesive whole. But they must work energetically towards that Truth, for only then can they live together in harmony."



It is important to note that the Global Mind is the Mind of God, so far as human beings are concerned. In other words, it is the Mind that was in Christ Jesus, which is the Buddha Mind, and when It is in us, all things are possible, and we shall be able to do even greater works than those that were done by Jesus. (Phil. 2:5, Mat. 19:26, John 14:12)

Those who attempt to achieve Globalism by physical, economic or political means are doomed to fail. All such attempts are merely forms of Utopianism, which has been the *'fantasy of foolish people'* down through the ages. On the other hand, True Globalism will occur quite naturally of its own accord when people begin to live their lives according to the *'Golden Rule,'* and begin to treat all others as they would like to be treated themselves. In such a state of being, there will be little necessity for governments to exist, since one of the primary purposes of government is to ensure that individuals do not inflict harm upon one another.

The thought of a world without governance tends to befuddle our mortal minds, which cannot conceive of universally expressed moral behavior without the imposition of some outer authority. However, what will occur is that the Universal Spirit of this World, which is Christ, will *'come again'* to

express Itself from the inside out of us, in a way that is benevolent to all. In other words, God's Good Will for every human being, becomes coexistent with our own personal will. Consequently, whatever it is that we want to do will always be considerate of others.

Those who advocate 'World Government' in the name of Globalism are advocates of tyranny, and simply want to control the world for their own purpose. The minions who support them are foolish people who are easily deceived and swayed by false promises. Unknowingly, they are supporting the very means of their own despair, and ultimate demise. Simply look at history, and note how many millions of people have been slaughtered by their own governments in the name of utopian collectivist philosophies such as communism and socialism, which are little more than the political codification of 'tribaleconomics.'

The vision of the 'faux globalists' and 'world government advocates' is quite simple. They see a world in which a select group of self-righteous, power hungry individuals will rise to the top, while the rest of humanity becomes enslaved to the dictates of the privileged few.
