Following is a spoken Invocation to be read aloud prior to performing the 'Great GodSong' posture prayer.

As a child I saw the World through the 'eye of my flesh,' located in my navel, and I perceived all things through the senses of my 'mortal mind,' made of time, and filled with hidden fears.

As a youth, I began to see the events of the World through the 'eye of my mind,' located in my brow, and I perceived all things through veils of conflicting desires, arising out of my hidden fears in the hope of overcoming them.

As an adult, I began to see my inner World through the transcendent 'eye of my spirit,' located in my heart, and I saw myself as I am, filled with hidden fears and conflicting desires that only Love can resolve for Good.

And now in Christ, I see the World through the 'Eye of God,' located in every single human heart as the 'I Am that I Am.' And I see all things with an 'Awareness of Oneness,' which is the 'Perfect Love' that casts out all fear and desire in order to inspire a more Abundant expression of Life. And so in knowing that 'God is the Love that I Am' I sing:
